Historical Note

The Conference of Further Education and Youth Service Officers (Wales) was established in 1951, but documentation until 1957 is missing.

Originally an annual event at which colleagues from the whole of Wales could meet, exchange ideas and study topics of general interest^ the conference became an Association in 1969, although an annual fee distinct from a conference fee was instituted in; 1961. From 1962 - 1970 the body was affiliated to N.A.Y.S.O.* and fraternal relations are still in operation with N.A.Y.C.E.O. allowing for the interchange of information, invitations to send representatives to conference, and the occasional meetings of officers to discuss topics of mutual interest. In 1976 meetings were instituted on an occasional basis, to include colleagues from Ulster and Scotland, from the 1st January, 1972 the Association has been "in association with the N.U.T. every Further Education or Youth Service Officer admitted to membership of the W.A.F.E.Y.S.O. thereby acquiring the rights and benefits of the N.U.T."

(Constitutional Amendment 12.6.72.)

The present pattern is that a week-end Conference and A.G.M. is arranged for the Autumn executive committee meetings taking place additionally usually in Mid Wales* Among current preoccupations are relationships with Europe^ preparations for Devolution^ co'-operation with Voluntary Organisations and the development of the association as a body of professional standing and interests.

Through our relationship with the N.U.T. matters regarding salaries and conditions of service are being pursued.

Throughout the history of the Association there has been a wide representation covering all the Welsh Counties, and current membership reflects this, all counties being represented. Approximately 85% of those eligible for membership in Wales do actually belong to the Association.

The role of the Association has developed over the years, and we are considering ways of contributing to Further Education in Wales as a professional body, being at present the only body which can legitimately be said to be in a position to speak for the statutory Youth Service over the whole of the Principality.

In 1978 by a constitutional amendment, full time paid professional L.E.A. Adult Literacy Officers became eligible for membership.
